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
Parent/Carers Guide to Bullying

Children fall out. Children sometimes make the wrong choice. Children get frustrated with one another... as we sometimes do as adults! ③

Is this always bullying? Or is this sometimes children still learning, needing support and making the wrong choices?

We have had an increase in the words 'being bullied' or 'bullying' but on investigation, it is not. We will be working on this understanding with the children.

We teach the children the acronym STOP and this is a good tool to use with your child to explore the situation and help us put the right steps into place.



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
