ANNUAL CONSENT FORM

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WALKING HOME: As always, we have sent out the annual consents before the holidays for you to update. We have a large amount missing and we need these back as soon as possible. Children will not be permitted to walk home alone with out written consent. COLLECTION: Every child must have a secret password provided on the annual consent forms. Staff will request this if they do not know the person collecting and if they cannot provide this, we will not release your child. This is for safeguarding purposes and is none negotiable. It is the responsibility of parents/carers to inform school of any changes to collection.

MEDICAL CONDITIONS: It is always the responsibility of parents/carers to update the school office of ANY changes to your children's medical conditions/ health. Regarding asthma, a form needs to be completed and an inhaler AND spacer must be provided and remain in school. The inhaled must be in the box with the prescription label visible - without this it will not be accepted. GP surgeries are happy to prescribe extra for this. Again, it is the responsibility of parents/carers to ensure that these are in date.
